Dexter, Missouri - The seedings and bracket for the SEMO Conference Baseball Tournament was released Wednesday, April 27, 2016.

Poplar Bluff earned the #1 seed with a record of 20-4. Kennett received the #2 seed with a record of 10-6. Notre Dame is the #3 seed with a record of 10-6.

Sikeston (12-6) was seeded #4, Jackson (12-10) is ranked #5, Cape Central (11-7) was seeded #6, New Madrid County Central (5-11) received the #7 seed and Dexter finished last with the #8 seed with a record of 6-13.

On Friday, April 29th the higher-seeded teams will host the first round of games. Saturday's semifinals will be played at Notre Dame High School. The Consolation semifinals will also be played on Saturday, but at Cape Central High School.
