"From what I understand a lot of their money goes to education. They are an academic-first school, then athletics kind of come in second, which is fine. It is a very good school and that is what I was looking at more so than the athletic part, was the quality education," stated Beacham at the signing.

Beacham will be majoring in biological sciences, pre-med and wants to pursue a career in Interventional Radiology.
