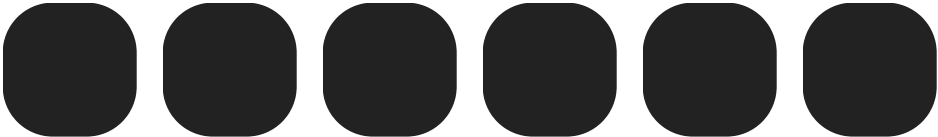
Bloomfield scored a run on a 1-out error, and a RBI single by Hector.
