On Thursday it's Red, White and Blue Day!

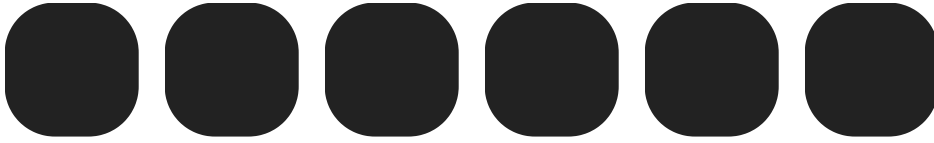
On Friday it's White Out Day! Wear white!

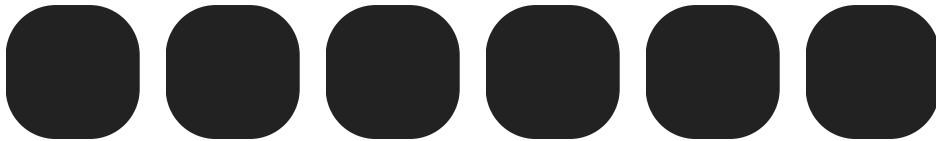
