The Board also approved annual evaluations on both the Gifted Program and the Personnel Program.

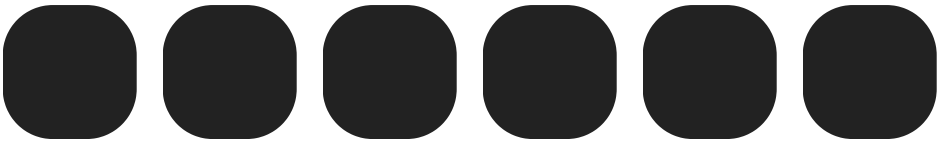
This is the second year Spitzer has been awarded the Overby Family Scholarship.
