

He is a member of Future Farmers of America.


His career record in wrestling is 16-11.

Hailey is the daughter of Billy and Lori Anderson.


She is a member of the Drama, Speech, & Debate team her junior year, track team as a freshman, sophomore, and senior years, and the Kickin' Cats the last 3 years.


