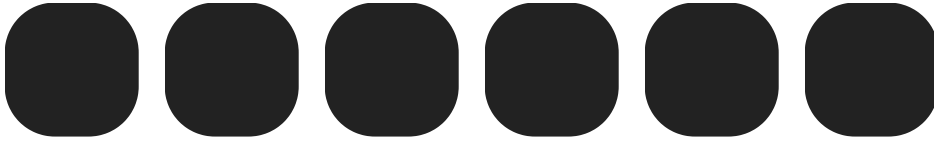
As letter carriers are keenly aware, too many of our customers live in challenging situations, uncertain of where their next meal will come.
