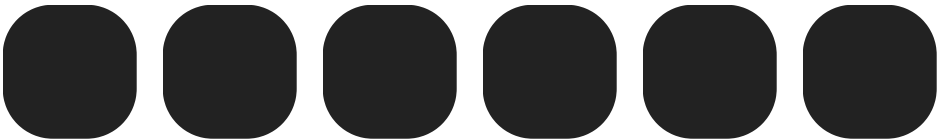

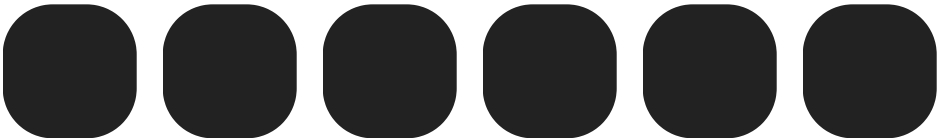
Each student received a certificate and a FREE Taco from Taco Bell.
