Top Female Athlete of the Year is Chaylea Mosby.

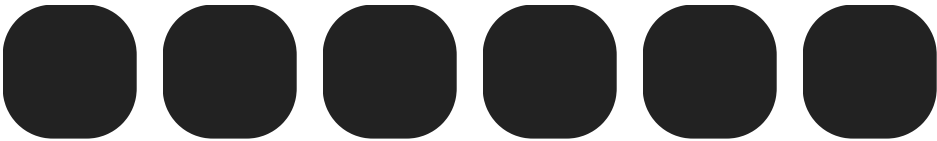
Top Male Athlete of the Year is Jason Jarrell.

William F. Danforth, founder of Ralston Purina, wrote the book, "I Dare You" from his person experience. He challenged young students to their highest potential in service and good citizenship.

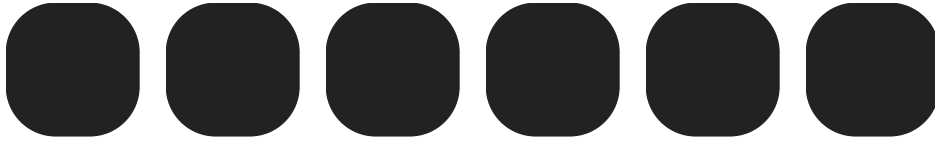

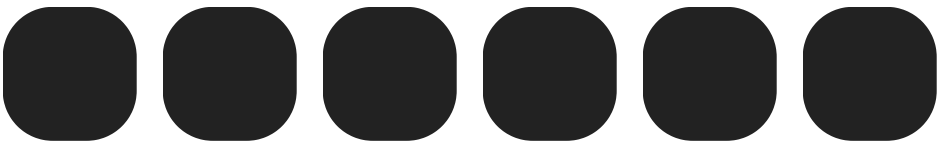
