Faith Felice is a 3rd grader in Mrs. Arnold’s class. Mrs. Arnold referred Faith for always being very respectful and working hard every day.

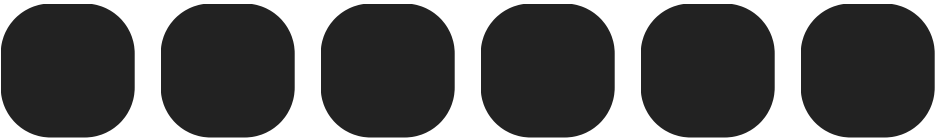

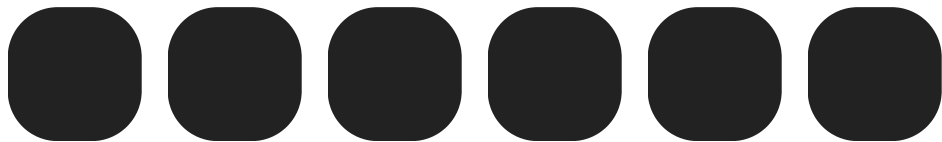
Aubrey Budde is a 4th grader in Mrs. Smith's class. Mrs. Smith referred Aubrey for being honest and returning something she had already received.

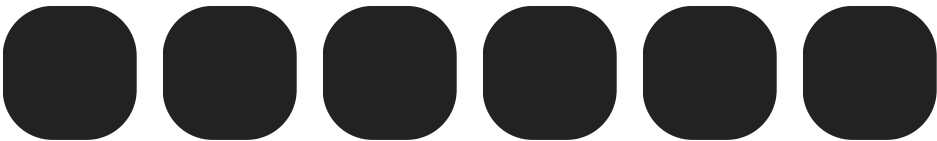
Sylis Parks is a 3rd grader in Miss Snider’s class. Sylis was referred for being helpful and kind to his classmates.

Mandy Cobb is a 3rd grade student in Mrs. Arnold’s class. Mrs. Arnold referred Mandy for working hard every day and helping when needed.

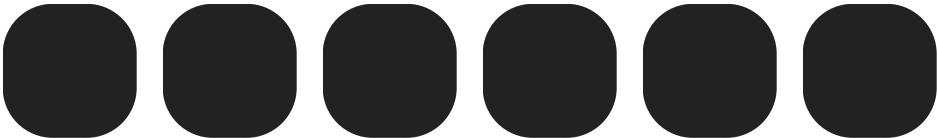
Haley Beasley is a 3rd grade student in Mrs. Arnold’s class. Mrs. Arnold referred Haley for always working hard and following directions.

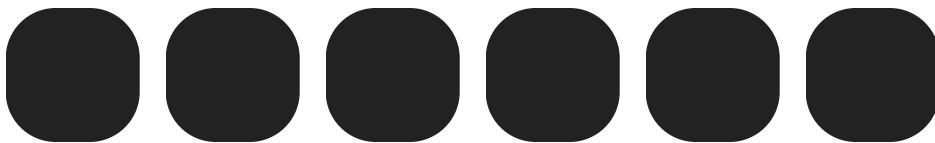
Aniyah Winkler is a 1st grader in Ms. Stone's class. Ms. Stone referred Aniyah for being responsible in class and always working hard.
