Funeral Chapel with Rev. Jeff Barbour and Rev. Ricky Lyle officiating. Interment will follow in the Dexter Cemetery.

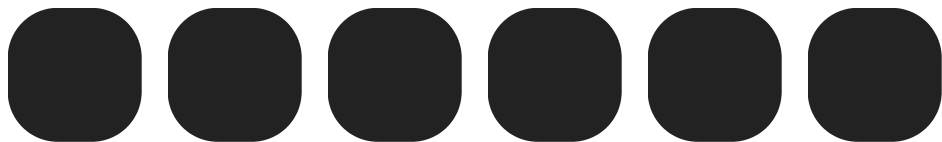
