Funeral services will follow at 5:00 p.m. at the Landess Funeral Home Chapel in Malden with Reverend Aulden LeBlanc officiating.

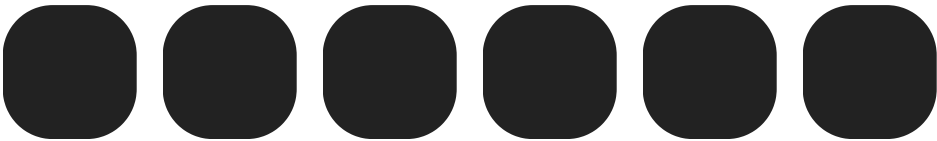
