Wing War has an entry fee of \$20 until July 5th and \$25 after July 5th so get in early! There will be Cash Prizes for 1st Place \$250, 2nd Place \$100, and 3rd Place \$50. Wing War Winner will receive \$100. Cook-Off is sponsored by Tyson.

Car Show Registration fee is \$15 for early bird registration prior to July 13th. Dash Plaques will be given to the first 60 cars. 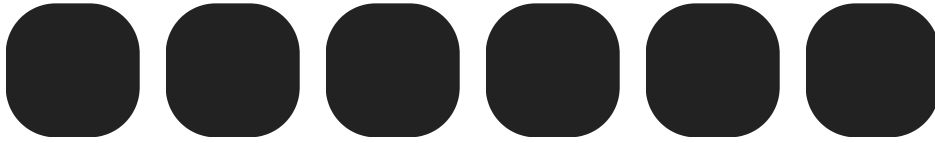

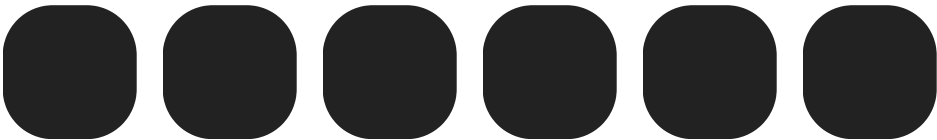
