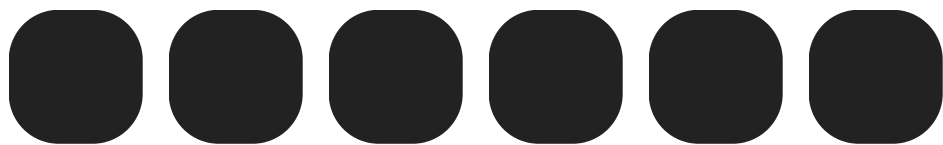

He was preceded in death by one brother, Darren Ray Williams.

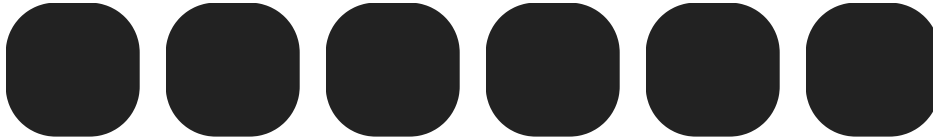

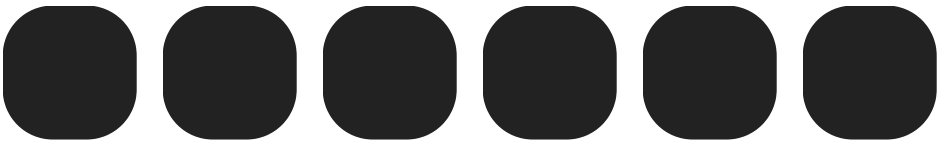
