Elijah Allen of Marble Hill officiating.

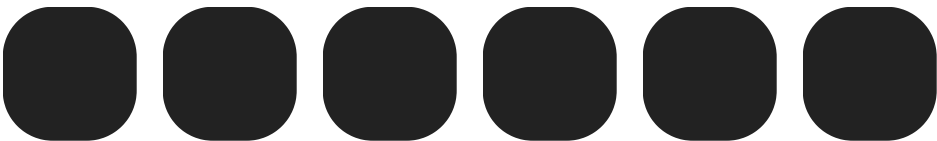
