The board offered a probationary teacher contract to Samantha Ward for the 2019-2020 school year.

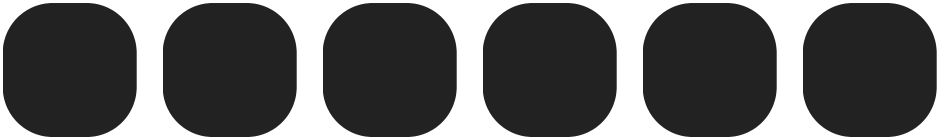
The next meeting is scheduled for May 9, however due to Puxico Kindergarten Graduation being held on the same evening the board voted to move the meeting to Monday, May 13.

The board:

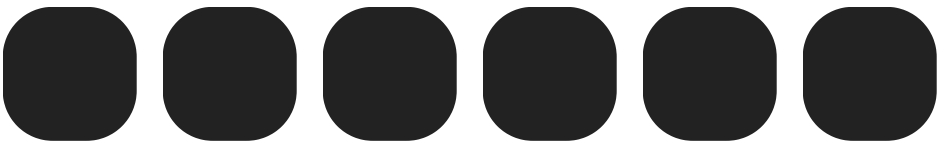
- accepted the resignation/retirement of Lori Vaughn and Rhonda Slaughter effective at the end of the 2018-19 school year.

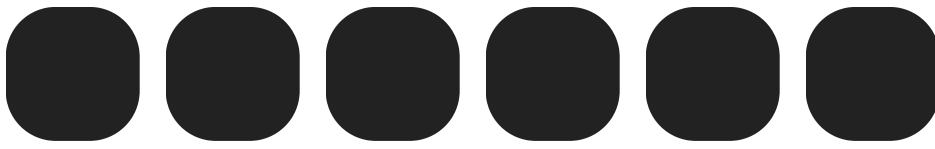

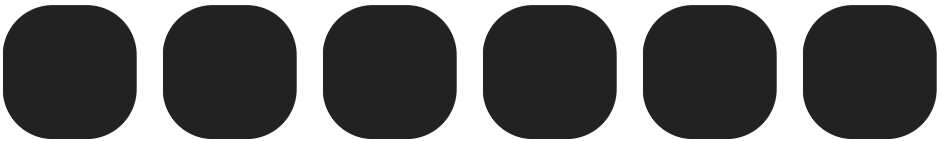
