Bryce, Taylor, & Macie (6th) all made great choices last week.

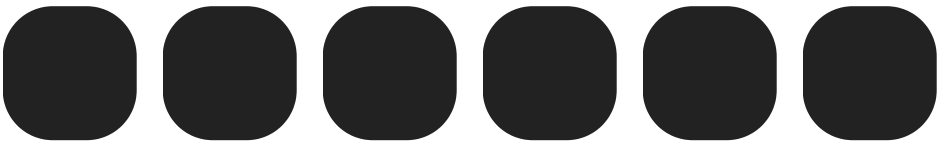

Ryan (3rd) had a great week.

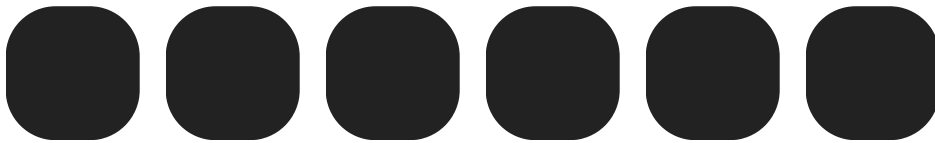

Creed (4th) asked Ms. Donna if she needed help after school and dust mopped the hall for her.

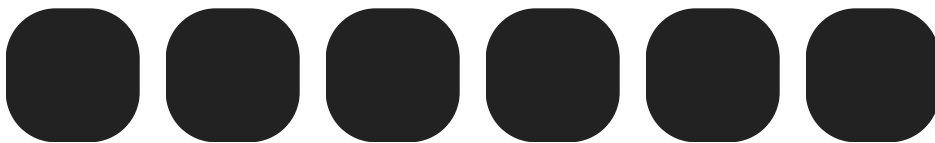
