Cost is \$25 per child and make checks payable to Dexter High School.

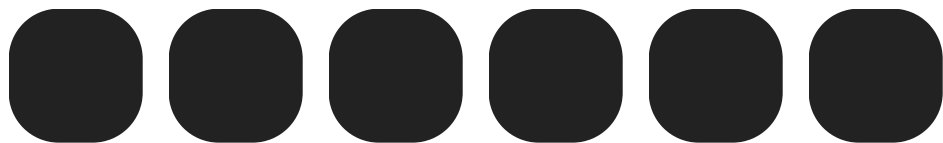
You can register now or the first day of camp, but to allow time for t-shirts to be made register by May 18th.

Free Physical Day will be held at SoutheastHEALTH of Stoddard County on Thursday, May 9, 2019 from 3:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Sign up today online with **Privit** to get your free physical! Just **CLICK HERE**.

A letter to parents/guardians from Athletic Director Josh Dowdy was send out on April 28, 2019 explaining the new registering systemd for PHYSICALS! It's FREE and easy to register!

"We are grateful that SoutheastHEALTH of Stoddard County will once again be providing physicals FREE of charge to all athletes who will be entering grades 7th through 12th," stated Dowdy. "FREE physical day will be from 3:30 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 9th."

"Additionally, Dexter Public Schools has partnered with **PRIVIT**, the number one provider for automating the pre-participation physical examination (PPE) process." That means no paper to fill out, just register online prior to the physical day!

The goal of **PPE** is to promote the health and safety of student-athletes in training and competition. By using **PRIVIT**, you will have the ability to sign the necessary documents at one time for your son/daughter to become eligible to participate in any

MSHSAA related activity.

The Missouri State High School Activities Association has endorsed this new digital standard for the pre-participation physical exam process, called Privit Profile™. This includes the MSHSAA's comprehensive health history questionnaire in a format that is easy to use, legible, and accessible to help mitigate injury risks related to sports. The system facilitates the management of the pre-participation physical exam process and provides coaches, athletic trainers and medical personnel the information they need to react quickly to health situations.

As a Parent/Guardian of a student under the age of 20, you will register an account with your email address, then add your student into the account.

Returning Students: If you created an account for your student from a previous season, please Log In with the same email address and password.

New Students: Select Register to create a new account for your student. Make certain to select your role as Parent/Guardian when registering.

As an added bonus students/families who have a completed **PRIVIT** profile prior to the FREE physical day on May 9th will be placed in a drawing for gift cards and prizes. Please note it will not be necessary to fill out a physical form if you have already enrolled in **PRIVIT**.

## Bearcats Bring Home Medals in Track

### Bearcats Bring Home Medals in Track

Cape Girardeau, Missouri - Eight Dexter athletes bring home conference championships in the South Division of the SEMO Conference Track and Field Meet on Saturday at Notre Dame High School.

Dexter boys finished second in the teams standings with a total of 70 points. Kennett won with 177 total points and Caruthersville was third with 46 points.

Seth Rogers, Cole Barker, Austin Guy and Drew Soule won the 4x200-meter relay in 1 minute, 32.93 seconds.

"They finished four one-hundredths of a second short of breaking their own school record and were the overall winners in the event," commented Kim Waldner, DHS Track and Field Coach.

Seth Rogers also won a second event the 100 in 11.4 seconds. He placed second in the 200 with a 23.23 time.

Austin Guy won the high jump with an effort of 6 feet.

Dexter girls took third place with 62.75 points. Saxony Lutheran won with 140.5 points and Caruthersville was second with 97.75 total points.

Margo Nea won the 1600 in 5:55.58, and Grace Milam won the 3200 in 14:51.54.

# Dexter Bearcats Golf Team Won First District Title in Nine Years

## Dexter Bearcats Golf Team Won First District Title in Nine Years

The Dexter Bearcat Golf Team won their first District Title in nine years on Monday, April 29th at the St. Francois Country Club in Farmington, Missouri.

They defeated 2nd place Farmington by 9 strokes to win the Class 3, District 1 tourney with a score of 333; Farmington posted a 342.

In 2010 the 'Cats placed 3rd in the state tournament.

“I would have never expected 333 to win today,” stated Dexter coach Eric Sitze, “but it did and I couldn’t be happier for the kids. They have played better but we will take it today.”

Spencer Warren of Dexter placed second with a 2-over 74.

Wil Claywell, of North County, won the individual championship with a 73.

“Spencer was right there for first again today,” Sitze said. “He is getting closer. He started out minus-3 on his first four holes. We had an hour-plus rain delay that might have affected his momentum a little.”

All five Dexter golfers placed in the top 16.

Dylan Sitze tied for 6th with 82, Cy Worley tied for ninth with 88, Ryan Collier was 11th with 89, and Luke Becker was 16th with 92.

Dexter will compete in the Class 3 Sectional Tournament Monday, May 6, 2019 at Crown Pointe Golf Course in Farmington.
