He is the son of Tammy and Paul Johnson.

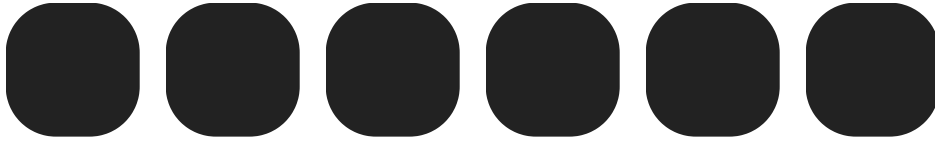
Andreas was awarded the Curry College Excellence in Education Scholarship and the Curry College Resident Award totalling \$70,000.

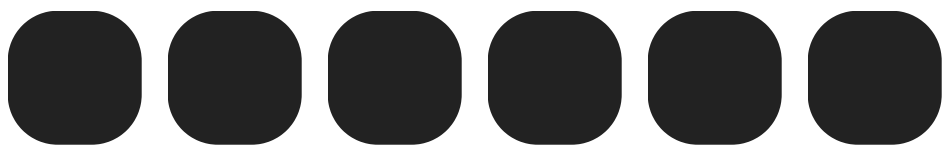

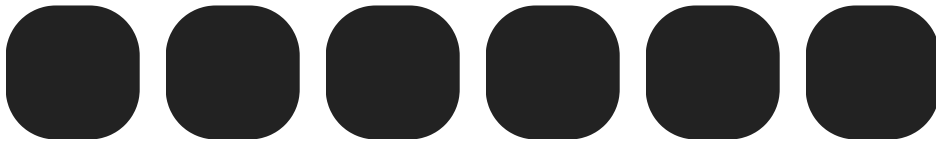

These are in addition to any other scholarships and special program acceptances at the University.

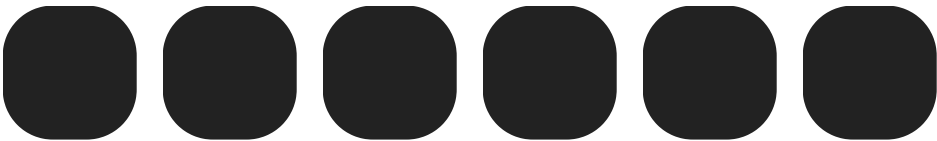
Wyman will attend the Missouri School of Journalism this fall in Columbia.
