Stoddard County, Missouri - The Stoddard County Commissioners signed a proclamation today proclaiming October 4, 2019 as Manufacturing Day 2019 in Stoddard County.

Manufacturing Day 2019 Proclamation

WHEREAS, Economists agree that there are three ways to create wealth: Mine It; Grow It; or Make It. Missouri is rich in natural and agricultural resources and Missouri manufacturers make everything from automobiles to aircraft parts to food products to furniture, chemicals, and electrical equipment including products sold directly to consumers and parts of other manufactured goods; and

WHEREAS, there are nearly 6,000 manufacturing companies in Missouri and they contribute more than \$40 billion or 13.2 percent of the Total Gross State Product, creating wealth for the more than 265,000 people directly employed in manufacturing and the many more whose livelihoods are indirectly supported by manufacturing; and

WHEREAS, manufacturing jobs provide an annual compensation which is more than \$10,000 higher than the state's average wage; and

WHEREAS; manufacturing jobs enable Missouri families to realize the dreams of owning a home, educating children and enjoying a secure retirement; and

WHEREAS, manufacturers pay millions of dollars annually to support public education, law enforcement, emergency preparedness, public works and other essential services.

NOW, THEREFORE, Stoddard County does hereby proclaim October 4, 2019 as Manufacturing Day in Stoddard County. And, I commend Missouri Enterprise and the Manufacturing Extension Partnership for the valuable technical and business assistance that they provide to our small and medium sized manufacturers.

Dexter Police Will Crack Down on Child Restraint Violations

Missouri Law Requires Children under Eight to Be Restrained in Child Safety Seat.

Dexter, Missouri - Missouri law requires all children under the age of eight to be in an appropriate child safety seat or booster seat unless they are 80 lbs or 4'9" tall.

Dexter Police announced today they are joining with law enforcement agencies across the state September 15-21 for the annual Child Passenger Safety Week Law Enforcement Campaign to help reduce highway fatalities and serious injuries by cracking down on Missouri's child safety seat law violators.

Car crashes are one of the leading killers of kids. The proper use of a booster seat can reduce the risk of serious injury by 45 percent for children aged 4-8 years when compared with a standard seat belt by itself. Using the proper child safety seat provides children with the greatest opportunity to survive a crash.

Chief Trevor Pulley said regular child safety seat and safety belt use is the single most effective way to protect people and reduce fatalities in motor vehicle crashes.



US Flags to be Lowered to Half Staff in Remembrance of 9/11

US Flags to be Lowered to Half Staff in Remembrance of 9/11

Wednesday, September 11th, 2019 marks the 18 year anniversary of the 9/11 terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center in New York City, the Pentagon, and United Airlines Flight 93 which crashed in suburban Pennsylvania. Patriot Day serves as a remembrance of the lives lost on that September morning.

By a joint resolution approved 12/18/2001, (Public Law 107-89) has designated September 11th of each year as "Patriot Day" which also directs the flags be lowered to half-staff for the entire day on September 11.

A section of the law is below:

- "144. Patriot Day"(a) DESIGNATION.-September 11 is Patriot Day."(b) PROCLAMATION.-The President is requested to issue each year a proclamation calling on-
- "(1) State and local governments and the people of the United States to observe Patriot Day with appropriate programs and activities;
- "(2) all departments, agencies, and instrumentalities of the United States and interested organizations and individuals to display the flag of the United States at halfstaff on Patriot Day in honor of the individuals who lost their lives as a result of the terrorist attacks against the United States that occurred on September 11, 2001; and'
- '(3) the people of the United States to observe a moment of silence on Patriot Day in honor of the individuals who lost their lives as a result of the terrorist attacks against the United States that occurred on September 11, 2001."
