Shirley Richard, Crowley Ridge DAR Regent will introduce the guest speaker Reverend Justin Sponaule, a Gulf War Veteran.

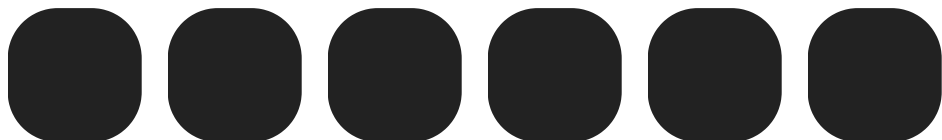
There will then be a moment of silence for the playing of TAPS.

Dexter High School Student Council (STUCO) along with Tim Holder, hosted a Halloween Dance.

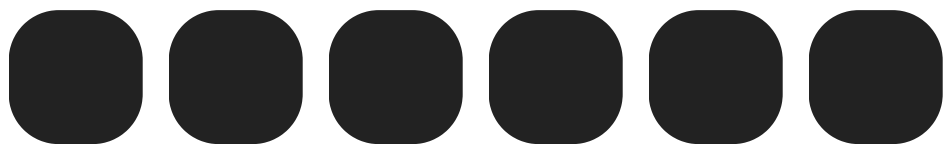
The students collected a couple hundred cans and \$350 to be donated to the Stoddard County Gospel Mission.

Caiden (4th) was helping other students in class.

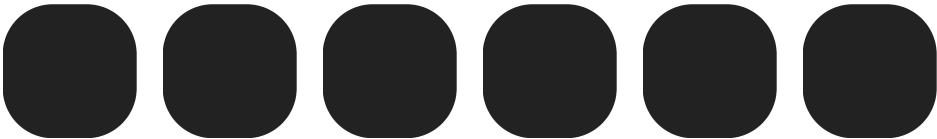
