Dexter PD Narcotics Enforcement Operation Results

On 02/07/2020, the Dexter Police Department, assisted by the SEMO Drug Task Force, Stoddard County Sheriff's Department and the Missouri State Highway Patrol, conducted a targeted narcotic enforcement sweep in the City of Dexter. The operation began at 1800 hours on 02/07/2020 and concluded at 0600 hours on 02/08/2020. During the operation, Officers conducted 95 traffic stops and conducted 11 residence checks targeting narcotics and drug paraphernalia. During these enforcement stops and residence checks, Officers made 17 custodial arrests and issued 22 citations. The following is a breakdown of the
