They encourage you to take advantage of this free opportunity to have your child's sports physical if they are considering any extra curricular sports in grades 6-12.

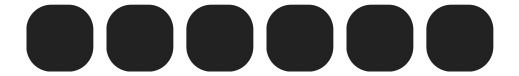


