Besides his parents he was preceded in death by one brother, Gerald Fowler.

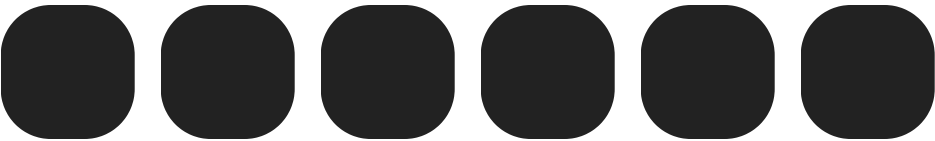

Service times are as follows:

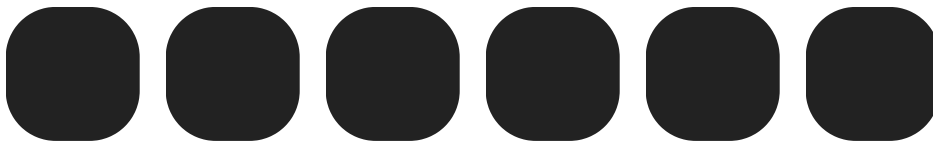
Visitation: Tuesday, January 12, 2021 from 4pm until 8 pm.
