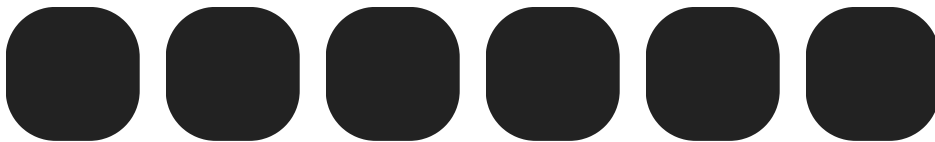

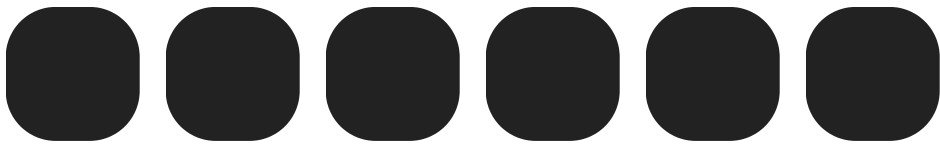
Interment will follow in the North Antioch Cemetery in Rural Bloomfield, Missouri.
