Other than by his parents, he was preceded in death by one sister, Arlene Gibbs.

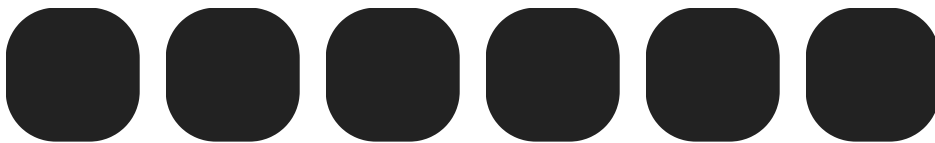

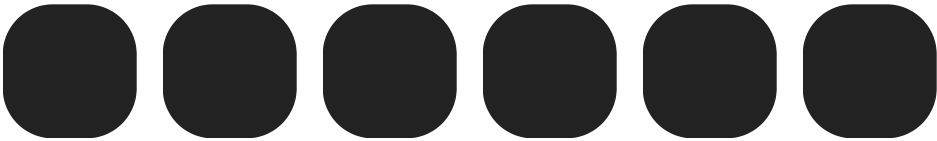
A memorial service will be held at Mathis Funeral Home in Dexter on Saturday, April 9, 2022 at 2:00 p.m.
