Ages 13 & up are \$25 and ages 12 & under are just \$15. If you get registered by May 2nd you will receive a T-shirt.

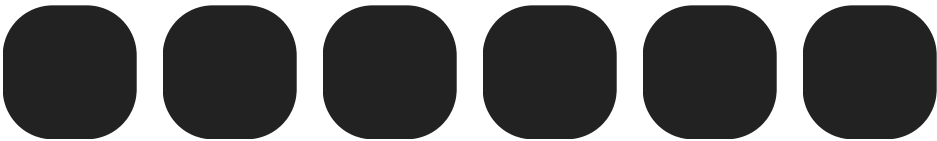
If you choose to wait until the day of the event it's just \$10, but they will not have a shirt available.
