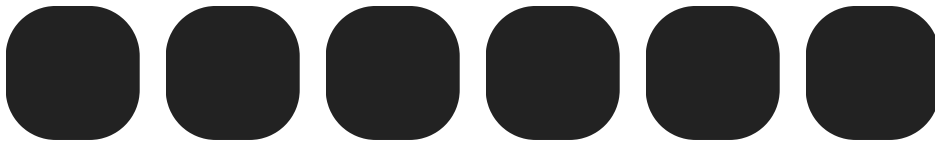

During Brett's career at Dexter he led the Bearcats to multiple Bloomfield Christmas Tournament Championship, SCAA Championship and the Bearcats were consistently ranked in the top 10 of Class 3 boys basketball team within the state of Missouri. Brett recorded 1,812 points, passing Matt Pruitt as the all time leading scorer for the boys basketball team.

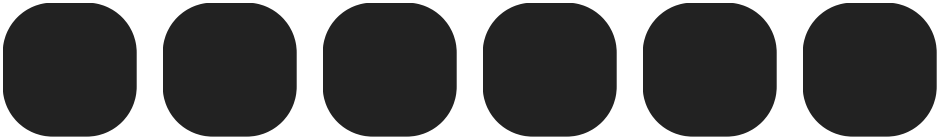
