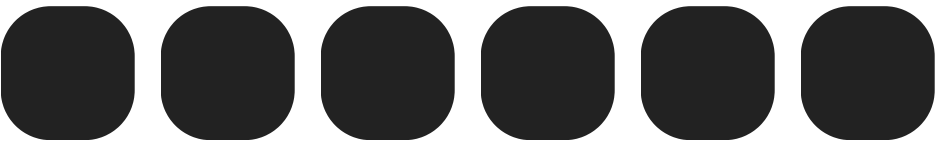

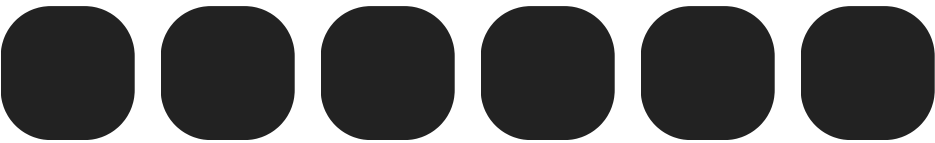
A funeral service will be held at 1:00 p.m. at the chapel with Pastor Josh Reasons officiating.
