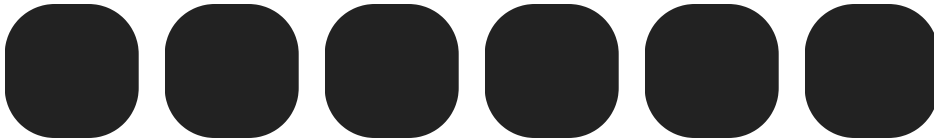

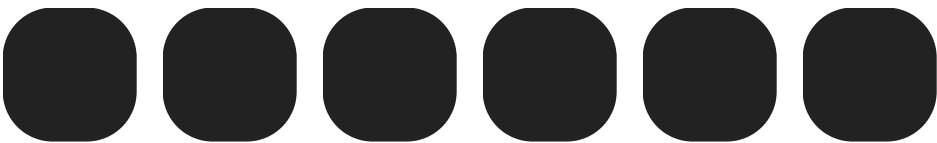

Dexter will host Jackson High School on Thursday, March 21st.

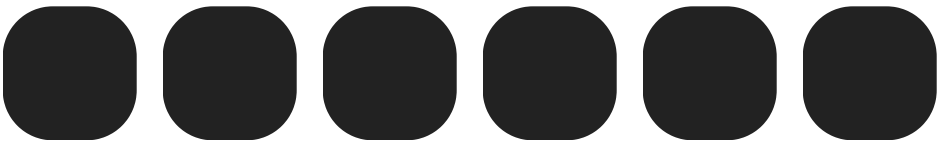

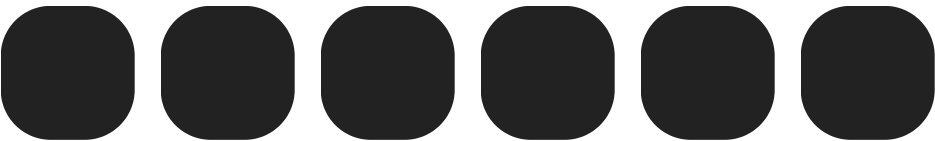
